EDUCATION GRANT APPLICATION

The applicant must be a full time resident of the City of New Castle. If the applicant is a dependent, the parent or guardian must also be a full time resident of the City of New Castle.

Applications must be completed and received in the Trustees' office **on or before July 1, 2017**.

Please call **302-322-2809** with any questions about the process or about residency in the City of New Castle.

An applicant must be a senior in high school or a recent high school graduate who is entering or attending an accredited undergraduate college or university as a full-time student in the coming September. The applicant must have a letter of acceptance from a college or university. Funded applicants from previous years who continue to be a **student in good standing** are invited to re-apply for grant funding if available.

Description of the Trustees of the New Castle Common Education Grant

The Trustees of the New Castle Common Education Grants are awarded for one year (two semesters). The amount of each grant is \$1,800 per semester provided the applicant **remains a student in good standing** and continues class attendance. A bonus of \$600.00 is granted if a cumulative GPA of 3.200 is achieved (no rounding).

A check for the first semester of the grant year is sent in the summer before the fall semester. The check for the second semester is sent once the Grant Committee has received the official transcript indicating the earned credits and grades from the first semester. All checks are sent directly to the educational institution so the accuracy of the information on the application is critical.

A new application must be completed and submitted each year. Grants for additional undergraduate years are made only if eligibility requirements are met and if funds are available from the Trustees.

Please complete each of the three items:

1. The Grant Application
2. Collect and add an **official transcript of your grades** to include the current school year or first semester.
3. For Freshmen, a letter of acceptance from your College or University.

All must be received by the date of July 1, 2017.

An incomplete or unsigned application will not be considered.
